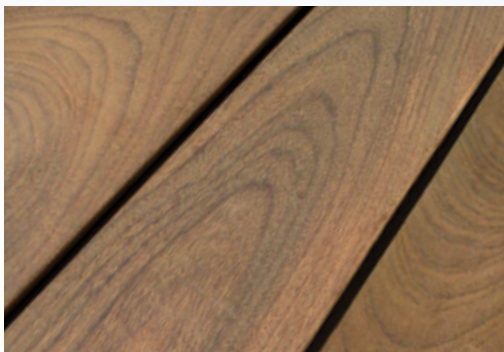

Peconic Bay Ipe is Air-Dried and Pre-Sanded, A Perfect Combination for the Northeast

Peconic Bay Ipe boards are always clear, all-heart and finest export quality. It's an incredibly beautiful, strong and dense wood that is not susceptible to rot.

Peconic Bay Ipe is air-dried.

On the American eastern seaboard, partially air-drying is preferred over kiln-drying because of variable weather and high summer humidity. Air-drying allows Peconic Bay Ipe to more easily reach equilibrium with the moisture level in the air. This helps mitigate stress on the wood reducing checking and minimizing movement in service.

Peconic Bay Ipe is pre-sanded.

Air-dried boards are stacked in a way that the boards often pick up markings and dirt in transit. Peconic Bay Ipe's flagship product is pre-sanded before it gets to your yard or jobsite, so you get a high-end, presentable look on delivery.

Peconic Bay Ipe is reasonably priced.

Air-drying and sanding is less expensive than kiln-drying. With Peconic Bay Ipe, the savings gets passed along to you.

All of our Ipe is legally harvested and subject to IBAMA, the Brazilian forestry certification program. We also offer FSC-Certified Ipe, the gold standard among green forestry certifications.
